Then take left onto Vistoso Highlands Dr. (golf club sign as well). Right before that you'll see a multi-story complex on the right, Splendido. Go about 1/2 mile (past golf club pond on the right) and park in the golf club parking lot on the left. Walk into housing community across the street. Concert house is the 1st on the right -- 219-8575. If coming from the south or west, take I-10, get off at Twin Peaks and go to Tangerine, or get off at Tangerine and follow directions from there.
